to offer virtual consultations and design and are more


determined than ever to deliver a rewarding renovation experience for you. Let us help you fall in love with your home again!


Design Solutions:


1 A DIY games table, built by the father & son duo takes up residence in the Hospitality Bar and allows guests to sit and play, have some snacks or iust watch television.

2 Embedded LED lighting, cleverly installed under the shelves allow for a cost-effective way to showcase collectibles and keepsakes.

3 Hidden furnace room (behind the screens in the Hospitality Bar area, storage area (tucked behind the stylish barn doors, and electrical box (hidden behind the shelf on the far wall by the fireplace) allow for the more practical side of a residential basement without compromising the design. All of these solutions make necessities easily accessible, meaning clutter is quickly hidden yet readily available.


4 Lighting in each area of the room is adjustable via dimmer switches.











S Exposed brick (introduced to the space) allowed us to 'bring the outdoors in' making guests feel like they have entered a different place altogether.

6 The homeowners' over-sized custom-made sectional sofa provides a relaxing space for everyone to sit, even if someone wants to stretch out. Made with durable, easy to clean fabric in a neutral colour, and lots of pillows—a perfect couch for the space. Whether gaming, reading or watching tv, you'll be as comfortable as can be!

7 Black painted overhead duct work and beams make the ceiling feel recessed and taller than it is, with industrial feel to it.

3 Reclaimed materials like shiplap on the wall and corrugated steel sheets surrounding the fireplace—combined with luxury vinyl flooring bring a rugged industrial feel, texture, and additional interest to the space.
