RenoMark Members return homeowners phone calls within two business days.



Feature Project

Maximizing Light, Flow, and Function

Kitchen renovation featuring wall removal and vaulted ceiling, plus the transformation of a utility space into a functional mudroom.





Client Bio

This small family of three loves to cook and entertain with family and friends. They wanted to turn their existing kitchen and dining space into their dream kitchen – an open mid-century modern kitchen that fit into their existing 70's style home with a modern flair. The mudroom design made great use of space to an existing underutilized workshop.





Renovation Goals & Challenges

The main goal of this kitchen was one large open space that was clean and simple but had a signature mid-century modern style and lots of natural light. The challenge was being able to vault the ceiling and add two skylights to an existing truss roof.


An additional challenge was the existing brick fireplace stack bumped out into the kitchen space.

For the mudroom, the challenge was connecting the kitchen and mudroom space in a way that was cohesive even though the mudroom was intended to be simpler and utilitarian, while the kitchen was more detail oriented.



What We Improved

- ✓ Added vaulted ceiling using new trusses
- ✓ Added two skylights for natural light
- ✓ Removed wall to open up space
- ✓ Made fireplace wall countertop deeper for alignment and extra storage
- ✓ Added walnut arched jambs at mudroom entry
- ✓ Matched mudroom cabinetry, stairs, and flooring with kitchen
- ✓ Simplified mudroom design for utility

A Room with a View | Optimizing Space & Layout

The homeowners viewed their Waterloo backyard as their “cottage” getaway after work in Toronto, and with retirement approaching, they wanted to enhance their outdoor living. Although the backyard featured lush gardens and a pool, the patio was unbearably hot. The solution was to convert this area into a sunroom that feels open-air when windows are open yet offers full protection from sun and pests.

Serenity Space | Use of Space

The original bathroom was spacious but poorly laid out, with an oversized tub, a cramped shower, and minimal storage.

The renovation reimagined the space with aging-in-place in mind. A walk-in tub was placed inside a newly created shower room, maximizing usability and future accessibility.

A small linen closet accessed from the bedroom was removed and replaced with a custom linen tower inside the bathroom for better storage access. The waterfall-edge vanity allows the shower glass to sit directly on it, creating a clean look while preserving counter space and allowing for walker clearance. The doorway was widened and the swing direction reversed to improve accessibility.


